HOW DOES THIS WORK?

YWRC Empowerment staff can offer one-time presentations, co-facilitation with health/PE/other courses or four-week long small group sessions for 5th - 12th grades.

Presentations and facilitations will happen virtually, via Microsoft Teams or Zoom.

Dates and timing are flexible to accommodate the best fit for school/student schedules.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

Reproductive health education is important for the overall health and wellbeing of young individuals. This includes their knowledge of changes in their bodies and safe sexual practices. By providing accurate, inclusive information with a trusted adult, students can learn without stigma or shame. While the ability to gather in person has become more difficult, we believe it is still important for them to have access to this important information.
