MISSION: To empower participants to be strong, self-confident, and resilient.


VISION: For youth of our community to grow to their full potential and realize the life of possibilities they deserve.




PARTICIPANT OVERVIEW

Why is maintaining or increasing resiliency skills important? One of our goals is to help reverse negatives effects of childhood/ adolescent trauma experienced by our participants. There is a direct correlation between trauma and later-in-life physical health conditions such as diabetes, heart disease,

high blood pressure, and more. By introducing and teaching these four key protective factors, we can lesson participants' chances of having trauma related illnesses: connections and strong social network, confidence and self-esteem. cmpetence and sense of purpose, coping skills and self-control.

Our Programs

Young Moms programs equip pregnant and parenting persons through age 24 with the support, education, and skills needed to be successful. Topics include self-sufficiency, childbirth options, child development stages and the importance of education.

Counseling services are offered for free, and are voluntary and confidential. One-on-one and group counseling empowers participants to identify their strengths, develop positive copina

Empowerment program curriculum supports participants through lessons focused on self-esteem, positive body image, healthy relationships/friendships, reproductive health knowledge, empowerment, feminism, and resiliency.

90% of Empowerment Participants agreed that the YWRC helped them learn and grow in positive ways.
